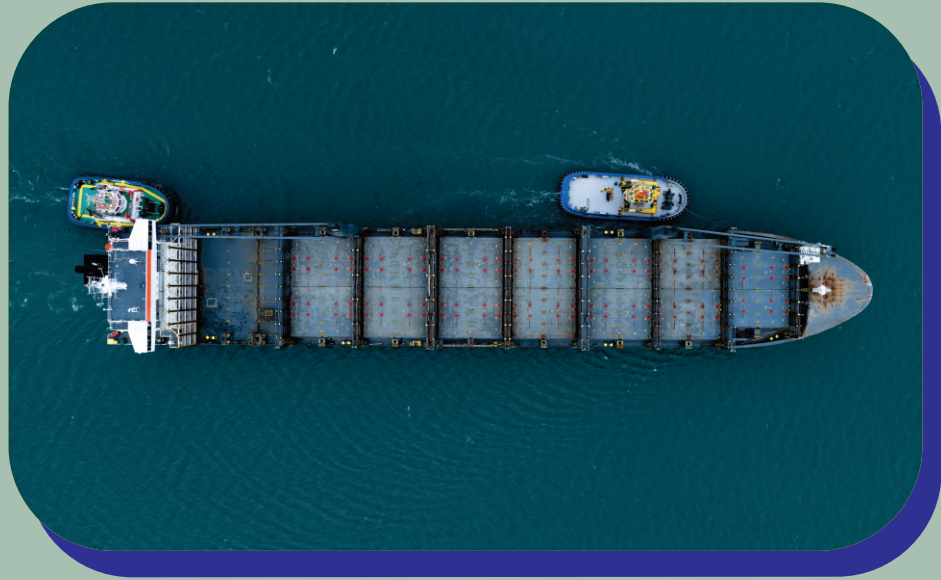




## ¿What is the OEA program?

- 01** It is a voluntary certification program of the SUNAT that recognizes safe and reliable companies in the supply chain of foreign trade. 
- 02** Seeks to secure and facilitate trade, aligned with the OMA (SAFE Framework).
- 03** Terminales Portuarios Euroandinos PAITA S.A. (TPE) is in the process of obtaining this certification and expects its business partners to contribute to maintaining security in the chain.

## Benefits of working with an OEA Company



-  **Greater agility and facilitation in foreign trade processes.**
-  **Recognition as a reliable partner in the international logistics chain.**
-  **Possibility of accessing international mutual recognitions (MRA).**
-  **Strengthening trust and business continuity.**
-  **Reduction of risks of being involved in illicit activities (smuggling, drug, trafficking, money, laundering, financing of terrorism).**



## Responsibilities of the Business Associates of Terminales Portuarios Euroandinos:

- **Meet the supply chain safety** standards applicable to your operations with TPE.
- **Keep the legal documentation and that of your staff** (ID, Police/ criminal background checks, insurance, permits) updated.
- **Ensure the identity of your staff and subcontractors** by verifying work references, backgrounds, and safety training.
- **Check periodically your facilities and transport units**, applying access control, physical inspections, and contingency plans.
- **Not being included in restrictive lists (UN OFAC, SBS /UIF, Clinton List).**
- **Immediately report any suspicious incident**s that may affect the security of the cargo or the logistics chain.
- **Extend the same security requirements to third- party subcontractors** throughout the supply chain.

## Safety Standards that must be known and applied:



- ✓ **Information security:** Confidentiality of cargo, customer, and operational data.
- ✓ **Facility security:** Access control, surveillance, alarms, signage, and visitor screening.
- ✓ **Transport and cargo security:** Container/vehicle inspection (7, 12 or 17 points), route traceability, seals, GPS, and contingency plans.
- ✓ **Reporting suspicious activity:** Obligation to alert TPE and /or authorities.
- ✓ **Personnel security:** Recruitment, background checks, supervision, and training.
- ✓ **Security in subcontracting:** Ensuring that your suppliers.
- ✓ **Cybersecurity:** Computer access control use of passwords, backups, and intellectual property protection.



## Reporting and communication:

In the event of detecting suspicious or illegal activities, the business partner must notify.
